flexibility is the range of motion in a joint or group of joints or the ability to move joints effectively through a complete range of motion. Ballet, Modern, Jazz and Contemporary dance rely on flexibility, coupled with the strength to hold an optimum range of movement, for example 'turn-out' whilst in motion. As pupils move up the grades the range of movement required increases. Our **Stretch and Strengthen Class** on a **Tuesday** evening at **Freman College** teaches pupils exercises which can be practised at home during the week.

Please check the size of your existing uniform as a guide. If your child has started classes recently we suggest waiting a few weeks before purchasing.

Uniform Reminders!

- All pupils should arrive at classes looking neat and tidy. All girls in Primary ballet upwards should have their hair in a neat bun, or if the hair is too short, a fabric Alice band to match the leotard. Please see the following link if you are unsure how to do a ballet bun https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=3yG7Hcozrf8
- Street Classes on a Friday, and 'Commercial Foundations' on a Wednesday should be wearing a black Buntingford School of Dance T Shirt (via Lynn)
- For Tap classes plain black ankle socks should be worn
- For Ballet in Grades 1 and upwards a waistband which matches the leotard should be worn
- For classes which stipulate black leggings e.g. Modern and Tap, these should be PLAIN black with no logos or writing or other colours

PLEASE DON'T FORGET

- Your child is not our responsibility outside of their dance class. If they are dropped off to wait for their class then they must wait in the designated waiting/changing areas. If they are not in these areas we may not know they are in the building in case of an emergency evacuation.
- We must NOT use the front door to Freman College. PLEASE ensure you enter AND leave the college via the pathway which leads up to the right of the swimming pool, and follow it round to the right, where you will arrive at the gym door and the Pavilion a little further on.
- If you have Modern/Ballet or Stretch & Strengthen classes in the Pavilion shoes MUST be worn. We suggest these are black / old ballet shoes if possible
- Our invoices and other emails usually come from our admin system if you find you are not getting invoices or other emails PLEASE check your 'junk' email thank you.
- Please make sure we have up to date contact details for you/your child.
- If your child is enrolled with us, we MUST receive written confirmation if your child wishes to stop their classes, otherwise fees will be invoiced and must be paid (see full terms and conditions on the website). Please also ensure that you keep a copy of this in case it is needed thank you.

BUNS – Buns should be flat ballet buns with hair net and bun pins (DO NOT USE BUN DONUTS). Grips should be the same colour as hair.

GIRLS SHORT HAIR - Girls with short hair that can't be tied back should wear a wide hairband to match leotard colour.
